Her work, “Lead the Way,” was selected as the overall winner for the Sixth District in the 2015 Congressional Art Competition. Congressman Peter Roskam made the announcement at a reception for local high school artists held at his West Chicago office.

Three students, including Ruoqi, were recognized for their outstanding artistic talent by an independent local judge. As the winner, Ruoqi will receive two roundtrip tickets to Washington, D.C. to attend a national reception and have her artwork displayed in the U.S. Capitol for a year. Two Merit Winners, Huiran Zhang from the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy and Alyssa Carbonara from St. Francis High School, will have their artwork displayed in Roskam’s West Chicago office for a year.
