Information Relevant to the Above Tables:

The data displayed in these charts was taken from the 2013-14 School Report Card, released on 10/31/14. The percentage of students in our district and schools who "Meet College Readiness Benchmarks on the ACT" comes from data collected over a multi-year period. College Readiness Benchmarks are set by ACT for each subject. According to ACT data, students achieving that score will have the skills necessary to succeed in entry level college courses in the subject. However, academic readiness is only one benchmark and a student's success depends on many other factors.

The scores shown here include results from the following three different administrations of the ACT Assessment for graduating students - (1) most recent scores from an ACT national test date, (2) PSAE testing during grade 11, and (3) college-reportable scores for students whose accommodations allowed extended time for completing the assessment. State averages for ACT data are based on regular public schools and do not include private or special purpose schools.

**NOTE: Prior to 2013, scores for students with time-extended accommodations were excluded.*
