The 2014 national average scores were **20.3** English, **20.9** Math, **21.3** Reading, **20.8** Science, and **21.0** Composite.

It should be noted that not every state requires all students to take the ACT as a requirement of graduation. As a result, Illinois average scores fall below national averages; however, they rank among the top of the states requiring all students to be tested.

Information Relevant to the Above Tables:

The above table reflect the achievement of District 86 graduates on the ACT over time. The scores from the Class of 2014 were shared with schools at the end of August. The most recent ACT test taken by each graduating student was used to compile the data in this report.

**NOTE: Prior to 2013, scores for students with time-extended accommodations were excluded.*
